During Mental Health week we have been alert to the needs for support and encouragement of those who either experience some issues with their own mental health or with those of someone they love. This coming week is Anti-Poverty week and we seek to be alert to the people around us who are affected by poverty.

Next Sunday 23rd October we will bring food for Meals Plus. We can bring canned and dried goods such as uncooked pasta, rice, cereal. This food helps in feeding around 60 people for breakfast or lunch each day of the week. This is a small thing to do but the results are amazing on the lives of the people who are either homeless or are facing homelessness. With 1 in 7 people in Australia living below poverty line Parramatta Mission is trying to make a significant difference.

On Sunday 30th October we will have another multi-cultural service. Please wear something from either your own culture or from another culture. We will also share lunch together afterwards so please prepare to bring some food from your own culture to share. If there is something you would like to share in worship then please see Rev Christine.

We are delighted to know that soon there will be a new chaplain at the Children's Hospital at Westmead. There are a few other procedures which need to happen before she starts and Rev Christine is looking forward to being able to introduce her to the congregation. Stay tuned.

Please bring in any 5c coins by the end of October as they will need to be submitted for the Least Coin. There will be a special service for World Community Day at 10.00am (for Morning Tea) on Friday 21st October at Parramatta Centenary Church (Sorrell Street North Parramatta).

We also pray for Scott for his Induction Service which has been delayed until Wednesday 2nd November 11.30am at Mussellbrook Correctional Centre. We hope it is a good celebration of his ministry behind bars where so few of us ever get to see. As Matthew 25: 36 says *'I was naked, and you clothed me. I was sick, and you took care of me. I was in prison, and you visited me.'* We are thankful there are people like Rev Scott to be with prisoners on our behalf and behalf of the church.

Luke 18: 1-8

1 And Jesus told them this parable to bind them always to pray and not become weary. 2 He said, "There was a certain judge in a certain city who neither feared God nor had regard for people. 3 And there was a widow in that city and she kept coming to him saying 'vindicate me against my adversary.' 4 And for a while he refused, but after a time he said to himself, 'Even though I do not fear God nor have regard for people, 5 yet because this widow causes me trouble I will vindicate her, lest in the end her constant coming will wear me out.'" 6 And the Lord said, "Hear what the judge of unrighteousness says. 7 And will not God make vindication for his chosen ones who call out to him day and night?; Yet God shows patience to them. 8 I say to you, he will make vindication for them at once. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?"

Reflection

The point of this parable is not that we need to keep bashing God around the ears with our wants until they happen, but that God is a righteous God who will do the right and just thing, and we can be confident that God hears our prayers and responds in a just and right way. Our encouragement is to trust God, and one way we do that is through prayerful communication with God.

This past week Lanes and Alleys happened in Parramatta. Lanes and Alleys is the council activating the lanes and alleys with pop-up displays, cafes, shops and art. This was our third year of involvement. Our Leigh Memorial and Leigh Fijian congregations, WSLARS, staff and volunteers were involved. WSLARS artists displayed their art in the coffee shop and hall, and the WSLARS band performed on the stage. Our Leigh Fijian Band also performed, and our Leigh Fijian choir sang on the steps of the church. Our congregants conducted tours of the Leigh Memorial Church, and provided hospitality. The courtyard had street art, and a gelato and dessert bar. When I visited each night, the place was humming with energetic people. Well done to all our people who took part in this city event. Thanks Donna for taking the lead on this.

Last week was also Mental Health Week, which is part of Mental Health Month, Two of our staff, Karen and Daniel, represented us at the function in State Parliament. We were talking about an innovative program in which people living with a mental illness work with animals in the RSPCA who are suffering stress. This program is good for both the animals and the humans in learning about stress and dealing with anxiety.

I attended a forum last week on the future of education. Attendance included former ministers and shadow ministers of education, the new secretary of the Department of Education, Mark Scott – who is a member of Wesley mission – the Managing Director of TAFE NSW, and the head of the Catholic department of education. The challenge is to further develop educational opportunities for people living in Sydney's Western Suburbs. A key word used was collaboration; collaboration between private, public, and independent schools, and with Business and TAFE. One highlight was hearing about a new Catholic School called St Luke's College at Marsden Park. Students will commence at the earliest of ages and continue there even beyond year 12, with educational activities and forums and collaborative partnerships for all people. Another fascinating aspect is that they will take integrate Luke's Gospel, hence their name, into their programs there so that students will have a thorough understanding of Luke.

Ian and I attended Parramatta 2021 forum. It launched a research on Parramatta and Western Sydney leading to 2021. Parramatta now extends from Westmead to Olympic Park, and taking in part of the Hills, Carlingford and Epping. One interesting highlight was the comment that the whole of Sydney needs Parramatta to develop, not in competition to Sydney CBD but as part of greater Sydney for the whole of Sydney to grow as a global city

This coming week is Anti-poverty week. One activity we are involved in is on Wednesday when the UCA Synod of NSW.ACT Social Justice Forum will meet in the Fellowship Coffee Shop, and finishing the meeting with a Meals Plus tour and lunch. They are keen to hear more about poverty and what we are doing to alleviate poverty. Members of the social justice forum include Ray Minniecon, from the Uniting Aboriginal and Islander Christian Congress, the Moderator of the Synod, Rev Myung Hwa Park, Uniting Executive Director, Peter Worland, The National Director of Social Justice for the Assembly of the Uniting Church, Rev *Elenie Poulos*, some members of Synod and Staff from Uniting. I am also a member of this Forum, representing Uniting Church City Missions.
