
## **BIBLE SOCIETY**

## REFLECTIONS

I spent a few days this past week in Brisbane with the UCA National Mission and Ministry Network. Here are some of my photos and highlights. I visited a Common Ground, 139 Kitchen, as well as some UCA activities.



On display in the Albert Street UC, six stations of the cross painted by a local artist, who just happened to drop in during our visit.



On the left a water path flowing through the square in central Brisbane. On the right the shadowed area.



139 kitchen is similar to Meals Plus. It has a pool table, and a pool comp on Tuesdays. A nurse four days, plus outreach. A GP for 2 half days. Acupuncture. Centrelink, legal aid visit. There is a men's yarning circle.

The photo above shows one of two day rest spaces.

Situated in Hope Street, Common ground provides accommodation for people facing homelessness. There is a social enterprise café, a community garden, health and well-being spaces, Art and IT rooms. It provides Housing Management, Support Services, and Concierge Service.





A hydro-bath at Wesley Mission QLD Asher house provides supported accommodation for 12 people with an acquired brain injury. One man had a stroke in his twenties. He cannot speak. He moves his eyes up for yes, and down for no. He can use a language board. He also plays competition chess.



John Wesley gardens intentionally develops community. There are 104 beds, yet each sub-area is designed for 5 residents in each small community. The staff are assigned to each community and there is no rotation. The residents are involved in the staff selection. Interviews include group interviews and include scenarios. Each area with same staff.



The story wall at new UnitingCare QLD building. There are 600 staff in the building, who cover all the admin/management for the services across QLD and NT, which includes hospitals, and Blue Care nursing and Frontier Services, 16,000 staff in all.
