Acts 17:22-31

22 Paul, standing in the middle of the Areopagus, said, “People of Athens, I see that in every way you are very religious. 23 For as I travelled along and looked up at the objects of your worship, I also found an altar in which had been inscribed ‘to an unknown god.’ Therefore, what you worship as unknown, I proclaim to you. 24 The God who has made the world and all things in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in hand-made shrines, 25 nor is God served by hands, as though having need for anything, since he gives all people life and breath and all things. 26 And God made from one every nation of people to live on all the face of the earth, having appointed and fixing seasons and the boundaries of their living, 27 that they might seek God in the hope that they might feel after him and might find him, God being not far from each one of us. 28 ‘For, in him we live and move and have our being,’ as indeed some of the poets among you have said, for we are indeed his offspring. 29 Therefore, being offspring of God, we ought not to suppose the divine nature to be like gold, or silver or stone, an engraved work of art and the meditation of humanity. 30 So then, the times of ignorance God has overlooked, now God declares to all people everywhere to repent, 31 because he set a day in which he is about to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness, by a man whom he designated, offering a guarantee to all having raised him up from the dead”.

Paul the apostle takes account of his context in preaching the Christian message. Here in Australia, in 2017 we have a different context and a different time. Yet the message is just as relevant. We are a Christian church open to the world, inSpiring the Common Good. One of our places is Parramatta where we have had the site since 1818, a church since 1821 and we plan on being here for another 200 years — to ensure we do that we need to be constantly listening to God and engaging with the public. This has led us to the proposed redevelopment that will transform our presence in the city.
