## John 20:19-31

19 When it was early evening of that day, the first of the week, and the doors having been shut where the disciples were because of fear of the Judeans, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you". 20 and having said this he pointed out his hands and side to them. At this the disciples, rejoiced, seeing the Lord. 21 Then he said to them again, "Peace be with you. Just as the Father has sent me even so I send you". 22 And having said this he breathed upon them and said "Receive the Holy Spirit" 23 "if you forgive the sins of any they have been forgiven. If you retain the sins of anyone they have been retained". 24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, the one being called the twin, was not with them when Jesus came. 25 Therefore the other disciples told him "We have seen the Lord". But he said to them "Unless I see the marks of the nails in his hands, put my finger into the mark of the nails and put my hands into his side, I will not believe". 26 And after eight days, the disciples were again indoors and Thomas was with them. The doors having been shut, Jesus came out and stood in their midst and said "Peace be with you". 27 Then he said to Thomas "Reach out your finger here and see my hands and reach out your hand and put it in my side, and do not become faithless but believe". 28 Thomas answered and said to him "My Lord and my God". 29 Jesus said to him. "You have believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed". 30 Indeed Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples. 31 But these things have been written in order that you might believe that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God and that believing you might have life in his name.

## Reflections

Today is a lesser known though equally important feast day in the church year. Pentecost, which is fifty days after Easter, marks a new era in the church. It is the celebration that God's Spirit, the Holy Spirit is involved in the whole of creation, and in the lives of people. It particularly is related to the energy or power to bear witness to the work of God in the world, in particular God as revealed through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The day was formerly known as Witsunday, meaning Witness Sunday, which accords with this reckoning. The Bible sometimes speaks about this as the Spirit giving voice to people to speak a prophetic vision of what might be in a world where all are able to live life to the full, and how this might be obtained through inclusion, advocacy, providing food for the hungry, water to the thirsty, clothes to the naked, visitation to those in prison, walking beside people on their journey of life, and speaking the good news of God.





I was very pleased to be invited to attend and preach at the Metropolitan Community Church Good Shepherd Western Sydney last week. The very attentive congregation particularly wanted me to speak about headspace, to which they made a donation. As well as speaking about some of our mental health programs, I spoke about Christian unity based on John 17, Jesus' prayer for Christian unity – it being the week of prayer for Christian Unity. I am here with a group from the congregation including

their pastor Robert Clark, and trainee pastor Michael, with the blue stole, who is training at the UCA United Theological College.

Tucked away in Megalong Valley of the Blue Mountains is a Uniting Church. The building is unlocked and the sign on the front door says welcome, come in. When Julie and I had some time away last weekend we did drop in. Check out the poem written by an eleven year old on the flyer inside Our News.

## inSpiring the Common Good:

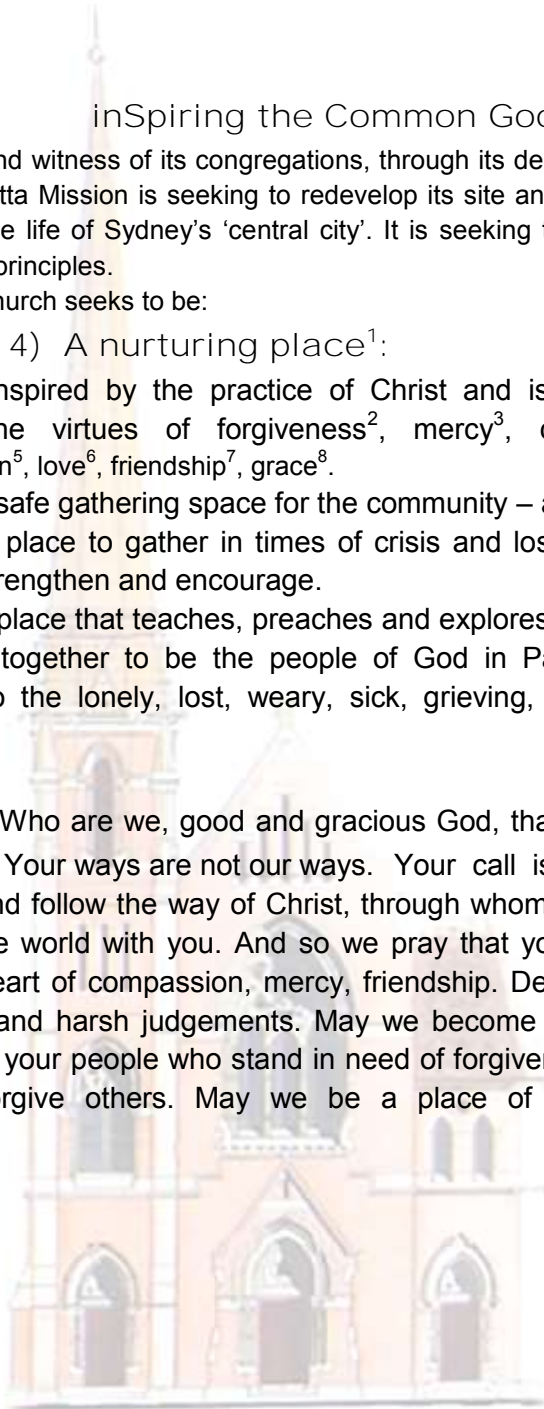
Through the life and witness of its congregations, through its delivery of social services, Parramatta Mission is seeking to redevelop its site and be a source of inspiration in the life of Sydney's 'central city'. It is seeking to align its life with 5 theological principles.

Leigh Memorial Church seeks to be:

### 4) A nurturing place<sup>1</sup>:

- which is inspired by the practice of Christ and is exemplified through the virtues of forgiveness<sup>2</sup>, mercy<sup>3</sup>, compassion<sup>4</sup>, reconciliation<sup>5</sup>, love<sup>6</sup>, friendship<sup>7</sup>, grace<sup>8</sup>.
- which is a safe gathering space for the community – a sanctuary<sup>9</sup>
- which is a place to gather in times of crisis and loss, to mourn, comfort, strengthen and encourage.  
which is a place that teaches, preaches and explores how we can be drawn together to be the people of God in Parramatta by listening to the lonely, lost, weary, sick, grieving, wealthy and poor<sup>10</sup>.

Prayer: Who are we, good and gracious God, that you should care for us? Your ways are not our ways. Your call is to take up our cross and follow the way of Christ, through whom you sight to reconcile the world with you. And so we pray that you will create with us a heart of compassion, mercy, friendship. Deliver us from idle gossip and harsh judgements. May we become ever more a gathering of your people who stand in need of forgiveness and are ready to forgive others. May we be a place of nurture and sanctuary.



<sup>1</sup>The metaphor of “a touching place” was initially used. That metaphor is taken from the Iona Community and one of its hymns which would have us sing, “Christ’s is the world in which we move ... and makes for himself a touching place”. It is a metaphor which reflects how often Jesus healed someone by touching them. It is, nevertheless, a metaphor that can release inappropriate signals and so the term “nurturing” was selected in its place.

<sup>2</sup>The ministry of forgiveness lies at the very heart of the gospel proclaimed by and through Jesus. It should be no surprise that there are many texts in the New Testament which call upon the followers of Christ to forgive others: Matthew 6:14-15; Luke 17:3-4; Colossians 3:13.

<sup>3</sup>Mercy, like compassion, below represent the strongest emotions to be found in the ancient world of Jesus’ day. The Christian church has captured that desire for mercy in its prayer, “Lord, have mercy; Christ have mercy”. Blind Bartimaeus asked Jesus to have mercy on him even when the disciples were seeking to keep him away from Jesus. (Mark 10:47).

<sup>4</sup>Jesus himself often showed compassion towards the crowds that gathered to hear him. (e.g. Matthew 9:36; 14:14). The apostle Paul encourages us to have the mind of Christ within us, and so will likewise refer to compassion if we are to imitate the way of Christ. (Philippians 2:1).

<sup>5</sup>The life, death and resurrection has been understood to be the way in which God reconciles the world to God’s self. Paul asserts that this ministry of reconciliation has been handed on to church, the body of Christ, and, by so doing, we become ‘ambassadors for Christ’. (2 Corinthians 5:18-20).

<sup>6</sup>Jesus bade us “to love our neighbour as ourselves” (Mark 12:31) – and ‘to love our enemies’ (Matthew 5:44).

<sup>7</sup>The gospels show that Jesus’ disciples would often call him ‘rabbi’, teacher. To be a disciple was to be a ‘learner’ – but Jesus called them ‘friends’ rather than ‘servants’ (John 15:14-15).

<sup>8</sup>In the New Testament Paul’s epistles always begin with the greeting ‘grace and peace to you’. (e.g. Romans 1:7; 1 Corinthians 1:3). Peace (*shalom*) is the Hebrew greeting, while grace is Greek. It comes from a word which suggests a gift; it is closely linked to a Greek word for joy. Paul describes the gospel as God’s gift to us.

<sup>9</sup>The word sanctuary comes from a Latin background, *sanctus*, meaning holy. For many centuries churches have been regarded as sanctuaries, a place of refuge and protection – and, for a period in time, were recognized as such by law.

<sup>10</sup> Luke 4:14-21.



## ***Guarding the Galilee:*** **inside the fight to stop Adani coal** **Documentary and Discussion**

Presented by Queensland born actor Michael Caton, *Guarding the Galilee* is a 30 minute documentary on the battle to stop the biggest coal mine in Australian history, Adani's Carmichael project.

The award-winning documentary team captures the raw beauty of the Queensland outback, where Adani's mine threatens essential water resources. Just downstream from the proposed mine, a grazier fears for the impact on the river that quenches the thirst of his cattle, that flows to the Coral Sea.

On the coast, a boat owner operating out of the Airlie Beach tourist hotspot worries about hundreds of extra ships steaming through the Great Barrier Reef each year.

Meet these and many others engaged in the fight and find out what mining billionaire Guatam Adani has planned for Australia.
