creeping things and flying birds!
- 11 Kings of the earth and all peoples,
princes and all rulers of the earth!
- 12 Young men and women alike, old and young together!
- 13 Let them praise the name of the Lord, for his name alone is
exalted; his glory is above earth and heaven.
- 14 He has raised up a horn for his people,
praise for all his faithful,
for the people of Israel who are close to him.

Reflections

Psalm 148 is one of five Psalms that form the conclusion to the Book of Psalms. The theme is one of praise and adoration of God. Notice that both the opening and closing of the Psalm encourage the reader to praise God. Yet not praise of any God, praise of God who is known to many as Lord. We also praise God because God hears our praises, as well as our cries of lament.

Praise to God is praise to the God who created all things and is engaged with creation. Even the creation, by its very being, praises God. What difference does it make to how we engage with creation to consider that the whole of creation praises God? If the heavens and the earth praise God through their very being, might that be an encouragement to us about the importance of our being? It is not that being and doing are two aspects of life; we are who we are before we do. Our being is the core of who we are. Our identity and value as humans is because God made us. Whatever doing arises out of our being who we are. Whatever we do does not add to our value. The intrinsic value of the entirety of creation is because God made the whole lot. Our doing, then becomes a way of extending our praising God with the whole of our life.

As the year 2019 draws to a close, we give thanks to God for this year. Most particularly, we can give thanks and praise to God for guidance, encouragement, love, comfort and peace, and prepare for the New Year, 2020. Our pray might also include a prayer of confession to God for where we have not loved God and neighbour, and then ask God for renewed strength from the 'God with us' for 2020.

May God grant you Christmas and New Year Blessings.
