1 But after the sabbath, at the dawning of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to view the tomb. 2 And suddenly there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone and sat upon it. 3 His appearance was like lightning, and his dress was as white as snow. 4 And the guards, out of fear of him, were shaken and became like the dead. 5 But the angel answering, said to the women, "Do not fear; for I know that you seek Jesus who has been crucified. 6 He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. The people remain standing.

An elder pours water into the font.

The elder then says:

The minister may say one or more of the following, and sprinkle water from the font by hand three times towards the people.

Sisters and brothers:

Always remember you are baptised,
and be thankful.

and praise the Holy Spirit.

The people remain in their places.

The minister may say:
