

## To the people of Parramatta Mission

Grace to you and peace from God our creator, redeemer, and sustainer

24 May 2020

In the Newsletter last week, we wrote that the Church Council on 5 May 2020 decided to conclude the placements of Rev Christine Bayliss Kelly and Rev Dr Manas Ghosh and the supply ministry of Rev Dr Clive Pearson, effective from 30 September 2020.

We also wrote that a Combined Congregation Leaders Meeting (CCLM), whose membership will be drawn from the three Congregations, will be established and begin meeting as soon as possible. The chairperson of the CCLM will be appointed by the Presbytery Pastoral Relations Committee. The CCLM will initially work with the ministers and congregations to explore and make recommendations on interim ministry arrangements beyond 1 October 2020. The CCLM as a combined integrated group will also begin to explore worship and pastoral care across all of our congregations. For further information we draw your attention to last weeks' newsletter.

We also reported that the Chairperson of the Board, Ian Gray, has decided to stand down from that role from 30 June. Ian will continue as a member of the Board and Church Council, including Chairperson of the Church Council. The Board and Church Council will work collaboratively to discern and endorse a new Chairperson. The three congregations' leaders are asked to prayerfully consider making nominations to the Church Council.

We also report to you today that the Church Council on 5 May decided to establish a new Parramatta Mission Council, effective from 1 July. The PM Mission Council will replace the Church Council. Membership of the PM Mission Council will initially include all current members of the Church Council plus members of the Combined Congregations Leaders Meeting.

We continue to pray for all who are affected by these decisions.

We pray for discernment regarding the recruitment of a new chairperson for the CCNB, and membership of the CCLM.

The chairperson Ian Gray, and the Senior Minister / CEO Keith Hamilton, are available to answer any questions people might have about these matters.
