



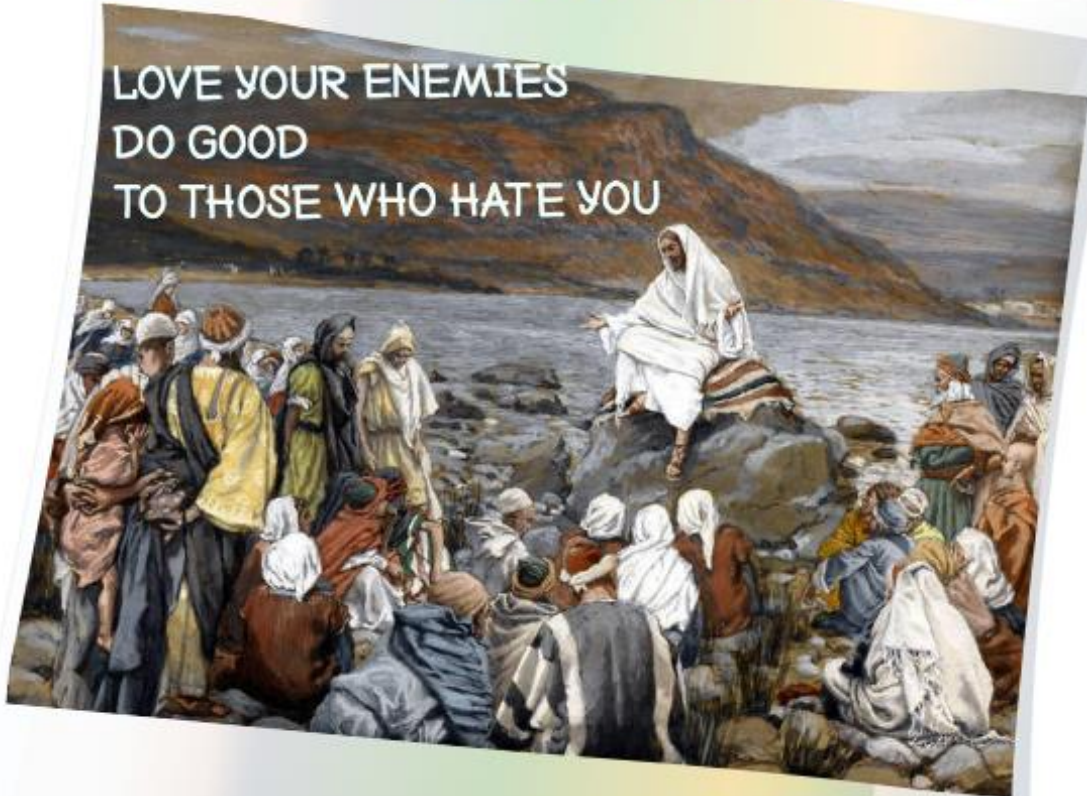

from the one who robs you.

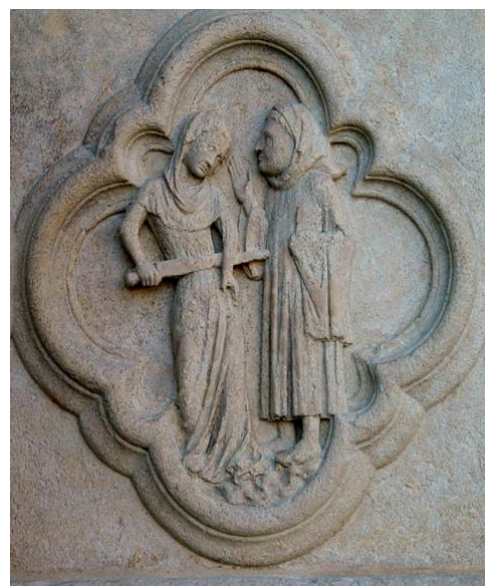
'Treat others as you would like them to treat you.
