

## **SCRIPTURE READINGS John 17.1-11** (Inclusive Text)

1. After Jesus had spoken these words, he looked up to heaven and said, "My Parent God, the hour has come; glorify your Son so that the Son may glorify you, 2 since you have given him authority over all people, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. 4 I glorified you on earth by finishing the work that you gave me to do. 5 So now, 0 God, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had in your presence before the world existed. 6 "I have revealed you 0 God to those whom you gave me out

of the world. They were yours; you gave them to me and they have obeyed your word. 7 Now they know that everything you have given me comes from you. 8 For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me. 9 I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours. 10 All I have is yours, and all you have is mine. And glory has come to me through them. 11 I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Parent God, protect them by the power ofbyour name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one.
