

7 But as for me, I will look to the Yahweh, I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me.

## Matthew 10:16, 24, 29-31, 34-39 (NRSV, adapted)

Jesus continued to instruct the Twelve as follows:

'I am sending you out [into the world] like sheep into the midst of wolves;

so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves...

<sup>29</sup>Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your parent God. <sup>30</sup>And even the hairs of your head are all counted. <sup>31</sup>So do not be afraid; you are of more value than many sparrows.

'A disciple is not above the teacher, nor a slave above the master; it is enough for the disciple to be like the teacher, and the slave like the teacher...

'Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth; I have not come to bring peace, but a sword.

'For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law; and one's foes will be members of one's own household. 'Those who prefer father or mother to me are not worthy of me. Those who prefer son or daughter more to me are not worthy of me. Those who do not take up the cross and follow in my footsteps are not worthy of me.

'Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it'.
